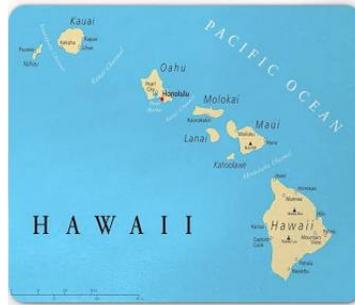

## DFS in The Aloha State - Princeville, Hawaii

Princeville is a blissful slice of Paradise on the northern coast of Kauai, in the Hawaiian Islands.

Today it is a resort town with hotels, golf courses and horse-riding trails, but its history has also featured cattle ranches, sugar plantations and taro farms.

The mountainous terrain of the area prevented Princeville Utilities Company's previous SCADA system, which relied upon line-of-sight radios for communications, from being able to provide reliable service. When they reached out to us for a solution, we recommended a cellular-based system.

The DFS system consists of six wastewater lift station RTUs, as well as RTUs on three wells and two water storage tanks. All use cellular communications. The lift station units track pump run times, well levels, AC power, etc. The fresh water RTUs are logically driven to automatically call the well pumps and control the tank levels, based on operator inputs. A twelfth unit, a network connected RTU located on the wastewater treatment plant, allows personnel to monitor basic equipment at the plant, like blower, clarifier and RAS pump statuses, as well as influent and effluent flow. When we recently spoke to Utility Director, Brad Suizu, a powerful storm had swept through the area the night before.

"It's working great," Brad said. "We were able to track the entire system during the storm."

Brad's field personnel are able to access the system via smart phones and home-based computers, eliminating the need for many off-hour trips and overtime expenses. "It certainly makes life easier," he added.

Being located nearly 5,000 miles from DFS might have been seen as a problem, but Kauai-based P.E., Kerry Mori of Advanced Energy Solutions got on-board early in the system implementation. We provided Kerry with field training for the DFS SCADA system and he also came to Florida for formal factory training. Brad said that they rely on Kerry or on DFS's free phone support for any technical issues that require assistance.

We're pleased to have happy customers in the 50<sup>th</sup> State and--full disclosure--several of us in Melbourne are itching for a reason to visit Princeville in
